Seeks companies that can provide a combination of quality growth at a reasonable price or Q-GARP for short.


Key characteristics:

The primary objective in the stock selection process is to identify those companies that can generate above-average earnings growth over the next several years. Although the portfolio is actively managed, it's our intention to hold stocks in the portfolio over a multi-year time horizon and realize relatively low levels of overall portfolio turnover. Portfolio holdings will generally vary from 30-35 stocks.
