RICHARDS RECIEVES EMERGING LEADER AWARD

ASHTABULA, OH – JUNE 19, 2013 – LEADERship Ashtabula County held its annual meeting on Wednesday, June, 19, and special recognition was given to several individuals during the meeting. Pam Palermo presented the Emerging Leader Award to LEADERship Class of 2013 graduate Ryan Richards, employed with the Huffman Mayer Wealth Management Group of Wells Fargo Advisors. “What a good year it’s been for LEADERship,” Palermo said. LEADERship officials also recognized two outgoing board members, Doug Hladek and Joan Billman, and outgoing, long-time Treasurer Tony Long, who will remain as a board member. “It’s been a great ride, believe me. There’s been many, many happy times that have gone with it,” Long said. “I probably have gained more than what I contributed.”
