- 3 years of experience in the defined contribution industry;
- 10 plans under management/advisory; and
- \$30 million of assets under management/advisory.

*The requirements regarding the practical component of the C(k)P® Designation are waived for professionals who are not financial advisors. The practical prerequisites may also consider the application of work experience and demonstration of the core competencies.
